Regarding: Adherence to Club Rules

Hello,

I hope that each of you had a great summer with time to be with family, go on vacation, and most importantly fly those new planes built during the winter.

Conejo Quiet Flyers has agreed an agreement (Attachment 2) with the **Conejo Recreation and Park District** that members will follow the Park Flyer rules as defined by the Academy of Model Aeronautics (**AMA**). The Park Pilot Manual (Attachment 3) on page 6 defines a Park Flyer and on page 8 makes recommendations for safe operating. A more comprehensive list of **AMA** safety rules can be found in Attachment 4, refer to Part B Radio Control. You should read over this material and be familiar with its contents. Copies of the full documents and other useful information can be found on the **AMA** web site at www.modelaircraft.org .

Your club officers would like to go over some of the safety rules,

REMINDER:

- **AMA** membership is required and a current **AMA** membership card must be carried at all times while you are flying. You must also be a member of the Conejo Quiet Flyers. We will be checking that you have your **AMA** card at the fields.
- Only fly quiet electric powered planes or sailplanes.
- Planes must weight two pounds or less (we will bring a scale to the flying sites)
- Airplane speed must be kept below 60mph.
- Planes can only be flown over the park site(s). Do not fly over the residential areas or the City streets or any buildings!
- Avoid the children's play area at Ventu Park.
- All planes must be labeled with the owner's name, phone number and **AMA** registration number (Attachment 4, Part A, 2(f)).

NEW: (Please refer to Attachment 1)

- Micro size planes 3 oz. or less may use the designated portion of the basketball court for landing all other models must use the grass area outside the flight line.
- All planes may use the designated portion of the basketball court for takeoffs.
- No flying behind the Pit Area or the Flight Line.
- Pilots must remain behind the Flight Line except when retrieving a plane.

Please follow all club rules so that we can maintain our flying privileges and be good neighbors to those living next to the parks. We want all members to be able to enjoy our hobby and we can best accomplish this by flying safely. If you see someone doing something that makes you uncomfortable, please say something. Safety is everyone's responsibility.
